For each session:

*Notice: this section is for after you have signed up and we have contacted you about a date or schedule.*

- You will need to have [Zoom](#) downloaded on your device, your mentor will send you the meeting ID and passcode
- Before your session, find a place for your device that will be able to show the entire part of the instrument that will be played on (so if you have a piano session, you will need to show the entire keyboard, but not the back and side parts of the piano) AS WELL AS your hands
- Send a PDF or high res picture of you sheet music, theory, or composition to your mentor AT LEAST two days before your session.
- Your mentor may or may not send you an agenda or information before your session. If they do, please go over it before your session unless they tell you otherwise
